ABOUT

Our Lana's Rosé came about after discussions between our co-owner Allan and his daughter Lana. This wine is a reflection of her bright, refreshing energy and dry sense of humour. A true Bordeaux inspired Rosé made entirely from cabernet sauvignon chosen to enhance the dry structured finish. This wine is made for drinking now. The perfect accompaniment to a cheese platter on a long summer afternoons spent with good friends.

WINEMAKERS NOTES

We hand harvest the Cabernet early in the season to ensure a fresh, dry style is achieved. Whole-bunch pressed and fermented for 30 days in old french oak barriques to add texture and structure to the finish. The ethos in the winery making this Rose is to ensure this wine displays a fresh light red berry fruit character whilst maintaining a crisp, dry finish.

2020 VINTAGE REPORT

We hand-harvest the Cabernet early in the season to ensure a fresh, dry style is achieved. Whole-bunch pressed and fermented for 30 days in old french oak barriques to add texture and structure to the finish. TASTING NOTES

A bouquet of crushed rose petals flows seamlessly into the front palate of this wine once the first sip is taken. An abundance of light red berry fruits, strawberry and cherry being most prevalent, are the driving force of this wine. The cabernet sauvignon displays itself most prominently in the fresh, crisp and dry finish that this rose' possesses. Perfectly made for drinking alone, or with lighter fare.
